Beds are bunk style: most single, some double, a few triple high. The two double beds are standard size. All bedrooms are insulated and heated.

Room reservation: an entire room may be reserved for a group of friends when all are registered, on a first-come-first-served basis (must fill the room).

Bathrooms: common men's and women's rooms are located on the second floor, including showers.

What to bring: headlamp or flashlight, sleeping bag or sheets, pillowcase, bath towels and soap/shampoo (blankets and pillows are provided), appropriate winter clothing and equipment.

Group size: there are sleeping accommodations for 60 people maximum. Overflow rooms may be available at the Inn on Newfound Lake (25-minute drive).

Emergency phone: guests can be reached at the lodge in case of emergency at 603-744-8011.

Arrival check-in: please sign in at the first-floor registration desk when you arrive (anytime after 3pm on Friday).

Common rooms: on the first floor is a large living / dining room with fireplace, couches, chairs and tables. On the ground floor is a small meeting room and a pack-up room (to store and dry outdoor clothing and gear). Hot beverages (tea, cocoa, coffee and water) are provided. Pets are not allowed. Quiet hours are from 10 pm through 7 am.
